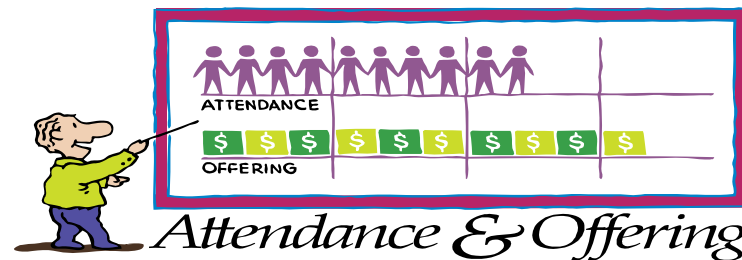

God's Definition of Faith

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." - Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV)

I imagine this is a verse you have heard and read many many times. Perhaps this particular verse has been analyzed by so many theologians, authors, and scholars over the years that we have grown numb to its power. But, I encourage you to take a fresh look at what the Hebrews writer is conveying to us through the power of the Spirit of God.

At its core, this passage speaks to the power of faith. Faith is not simply a belief, or a feeling that suddenly comes upon a person. Faith is tangible. Faith is substantive, in that it effects real-world results. Because it is our faith that is going to be the reason we are different from others in this world. Our faith leads us to give generously, no matter our financial standing (2 Corinthians 8:1-4). Our faith leads us to have different priorities for our households (Proverbs 22:6). Our faith leads us to put the needs of others ahead of our own (Philippians 2:3).

Faith gives us the power to make those choices, because faith points us toward what is yet to be seen. Even though we don't know what lies ahead, we know Who will be there with us. Even though we have no idea what challenges, or tragedies are waiting for us around the corner ... faith reminds us that our God will not waiver, and He will sustain us until the end.

And, when the end does come, it is faith that gives us the power to face it with confidence, knowing that we have a loving God waiting to embrace us and welcome us into eternity. Genuine faith is powerful. Genuine faith is life-changing. Has your faith had this kind of impact on you? Is it the kind of faith God expects of you if it hasn't? Think about it...
