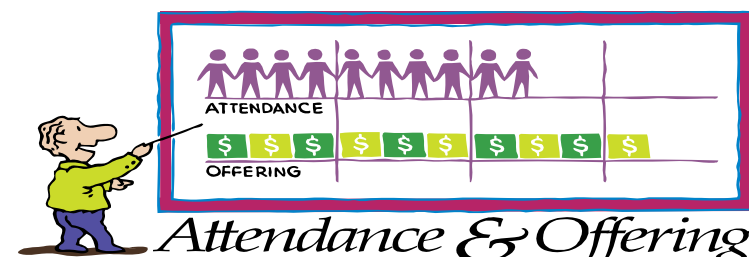

One of my first memories of Southside was at a family retreat that I attended at Big Reedy when I was in college. The thing that stands out to me most wasn't the lessons or singing (I should've been paying more attention, I know) but was a game that Bryan Dill introduced me to. The game is called Exploding Kittens. It sounds very violent, but I assure you, it's just a card game and no animals were harmed while playing. I had so much fun playing that after I left the retreat I went back to Bowling Green, straight to Amazon, and used the few dollars I had to purchase Exploding Kittens and the Imploding Kittens expansions pack. I was so excited to show this game to my roommates. I knew they would love it.

And I was right. We spent countless hours playing Exploding Kittens. Over and over. We played so much and because there were intense moments, particular cards got bent. If you paid enough attention to the creases you could tell who had what card and what card was next in the pile, often saving you from drawing the dreaded Exploding Kitten. Sharing this game with my roommates was a good idea and I'm so glad that I have those memories.

I tell you this story because it reminds me of how we should share the gospel. Last week I got to hear three gospel preachers speak. Bryan Dill, David Shannon, and Dale Jenkins, all three of which have an excitement for sharing the gospel that I hope to have. In a conversation with Dale we spoke about what makes a preacher. Do you know what makes a preacher? A christian makes a preacher. Acts 8:4 says, 'Now those who were scattered went about preaching the word.' Those who were scattered were Christians who had been persecuted in Jerusalem, and wherever they went they were preaching the word. So, yeah, you've got to preach. It might not be from the pulpit. But someone's going to hear you.

What does it mean to preach? To share the good news of Jesus Christ. It's good news. It's news that I hope you want to share. It's news that needs to be shared. If you're a Christian, technically you're a preacher, so let's get to sharing the good news!

Memorial Scholarship Fund



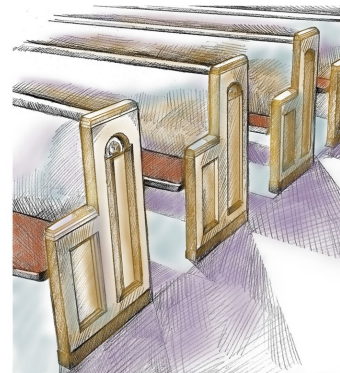
