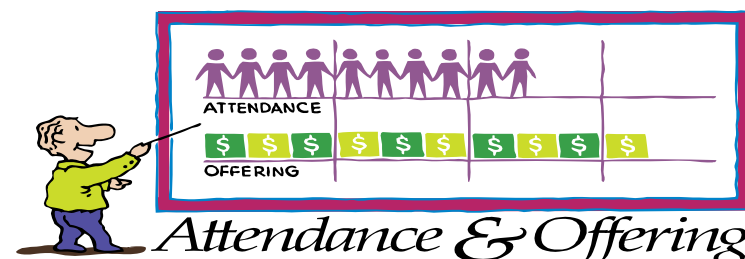

As the current sermon series on "Renewal" continues today, I encourage you to consider the principles covered thus far from Romans 12:2 and Psalm 51 and be thankful that God shows each believer His grace and new mercies everyday. Today, I would like to ask: What happens to a community when ordinary people find true Spiritual renewal in the gospel of Christ?

The answer is that it begins to open up God's extraordinary purposes in the hearts of onlookers and spectators...even neighbors, family and friends. The Bible identifies who Jesus wants us to become in our newness together, and I joyfully recognize all of these among us right here at Southside, Praise be to God!!

Here are 9 Scriptural attributes of a Renewed group of people joined together in His mission:

1. **A Church where Jesus is number one.** Psalm 127:1 "Except the LORD build the house, they labor in vain that build it..."
2. **A Church with a strong sense of unity and fellowship.** I Corinthians 1:10 "...that you all agree, and there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment."
3. **A Church that honors and follows the Bible.** 2 Timothy 3:15 "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for training in righteousness."
4. **A Church that is loved, supported and attended by the members.** Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of yourselves together..."
5. **A serving Church.** Matthew 25:40 "...to the extent that you did it for one of these brothers of mine, even the least of them, you did it for me."
6. **A giving Church.** 2 Corinthians 9:7 "...God loves a cheerful giver."
7. **A praying Church.** Luke 11:9 "Ask and it shall be given; seek and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you..."
8. **A humble Church.** James 4:6 "God is opposed to the proud but gives grace to the humble."
9. **A soul-winning Church!** Matthew 28:19 "Going and making disciples of all nations."

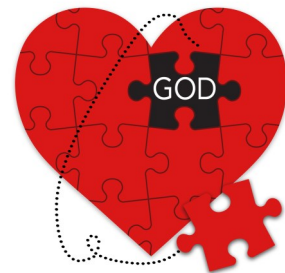

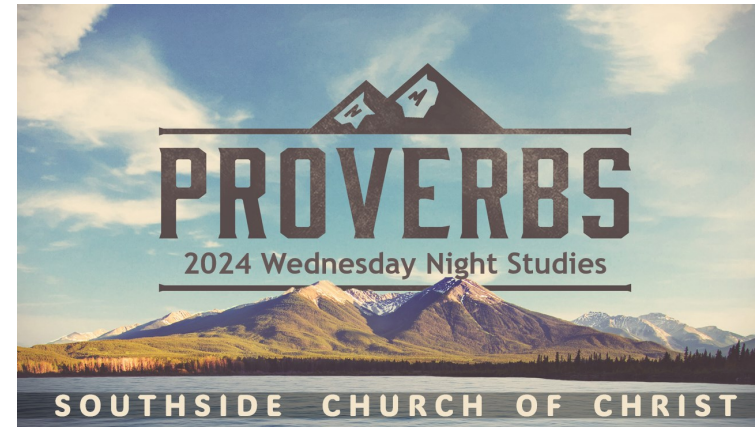
Church Bus will leave Southside at 10 AM and have lunch at WCB. Lunch will cost around \$10. RSVP to the church office by January 26th.
