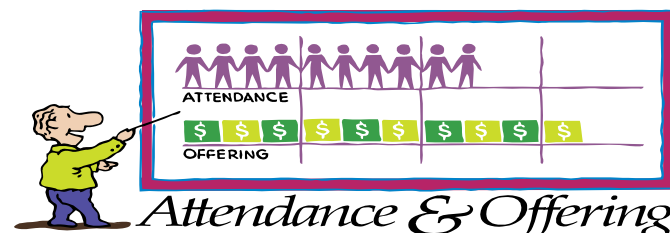

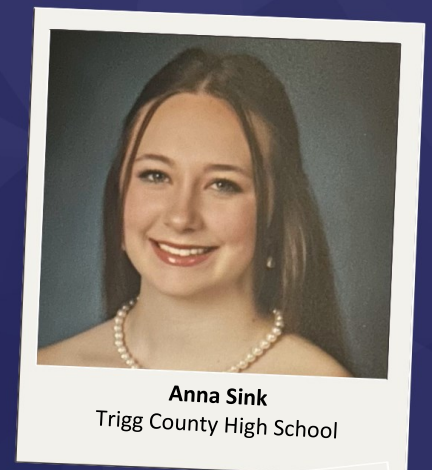

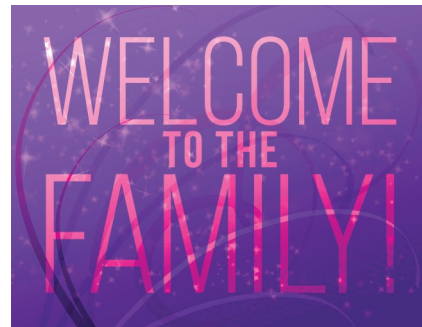

#### Ciudad de Panamá

From Panama, cordial greetings to my beloved and dear brothers in Christ Jesus. I hope you are all enjoying all the spiritual blessings in Christ. Beloved, everyone here is well in the Lord. We are in the rainy season. In this small nation, it rains 8 and 9 months a year. In the jungle of Darien, where our brothers in Christ live, and where I preached. During these months it is difficult to access by road and

by the mighty rivers. The form of communication is by WhatsApp. These brothers go down once or twice a month since it is expensive, gasoline is expensive. It takes 4 hours to go up the river because of how fast the river gets. We have been with them, teaching them from the month of December until yesterday, when my wife and I were with them. My translator left me due to responsibilities with his family. Now, I have to learn the dialect so I can teach them in their own language. A few speak Spanish. They, the congregation, are very happy and want to go to other indigenous groups to preach to them as well. The Church that meets in my house has matured and has much more courage to go out and evangelize. We could have baptisms this Sunday and some restorations too. Beloved, my wife is suffering from the memory of her (she is 70 years old), include her in your prayers, thank you. Me, I'm also a little sick with one leg. The doctors are helping me, there are days when it is difficult for me to walk. I look 80 years old but I'm 68 1/2. Beloved, thank you for her financial generosity and for her prayers, without which it would not be difficult to carry out the preaching. We are in election time, on May 5 there will be voting for a new president. Thank you brothers for sharing with us not only the gospel of Christ, but also with financial help that is very helpful to us, may the King of Kings multiply you with health and economy.
