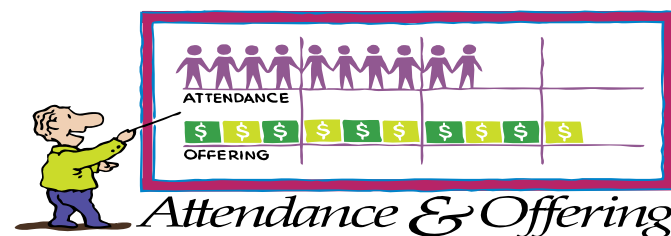

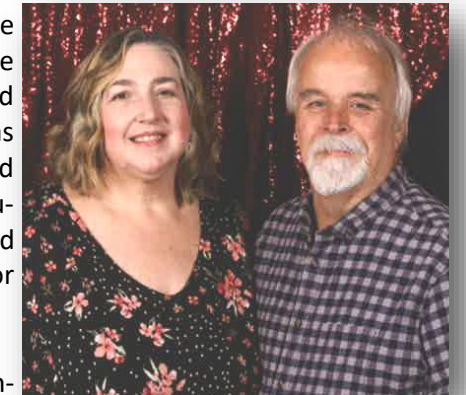

As I was preparing this, it hit me just how quickly time flies. Stacey and I have now been a part of the Southside family for 17 years. Over the span of those years, and well beyond that, through ups and downs, there has been the incredible comfort of God's love, mercy, and grace, without which all of us would be in a difficult situation. In addition to the love of God, the support and love from my better half Stacey has been my anchor through what will be 40 years come November.



My area of service as a deacon falls into the area of technology, especially as it pertains to sound, video, and computers, and when you think of changes over 17 years and how those changes impact the church, technology and how we use it for His cause has been significantly impacted. When we first arrived at Southside, the booth was a small area where one person could oversee everything that went on at one time. Now, most Sunday mornings, there are three people in a larger area, working to make sure that everyone gets the full access to the worship services, whether they are attending in person or watching online. When COVID sent us home for a month and forced us to stay distanced for a much longer period, we came to realize how important it was to provide video of worship, classes, and special events, to enable those who could not attend or did not feel comfortable attending to still feel a part of the Southside family and a part of the worship experience. I believe this is an important tool for the work of His kingdom, allowing others to be introduced to our congregation.

Of course, there is more than live video that happens in 'the box.' We handle the internal sound for the building, the powerpoint projection system that displays the songs and the sermon points, and the recently improved hearing assist system, which allows everyone to be able to hear all aspects of the worship service. Those who serve in the booth also are the ones who are the first line in security for the building as we have access to all of the security cameras for the building at one time.

Now, we are always looking for those who might like to serve the Lord in this area. If you are not comfortable being in front of people but would like a chance to serve, then you can join us 'in the back.' Several of our young people have started helping out with technology, but it does not have to be reserved for the young, just for those with the desire and interest to serve in this fashion. So, if you think that it might be something you would enjoy and give you the opportunity to serve the One who has done so much for us, just let us know and we can get your ready to roll. The one thing I want to make sure I state in closing is that we all have different abilities and skill sets, but any thing God has blessed us with can be used for His service. Don't ever think that what you have the ability to do is too small or too unimportant to help out the cause of Christ.

**"IF A HOUSE IS DIVIDED AGAINST ITSELF, THAT HOUSE CANNOT STAND."**  
MARK 3:25

When President Lincoln declared in 1858, "A house divided against itself cannot stand," he was echoing Jesus. Scribes thought Jesus was casting out demons by Satan's power, so Jesus responded, "How can Satan cast out Satan? ... If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand" (Mark 3:23-25, NIV). There are countless modern examples: Civil wars. Families torn apart. Business partners going separate ways. Even churches splitting.

Jesus used the "house divided" image to point out the nonsense of the scribes' words. It takes someone other than the "strong man" (v. 27), or demon, occupying a space to cast that demon out. Evil can't drive out evil. Sin isn't stronger than sin. Hate doesn't solve hate. Violence doesn't end violence. Two wrongs don't make a right.


Jesus came to "bind" evil with goodness, conquer hate with love and teach us the same. Throughout the gospels, Jesus treats all people with love — even those who oppose him — so that, in the end, we all will be a house united by God's goodness.
