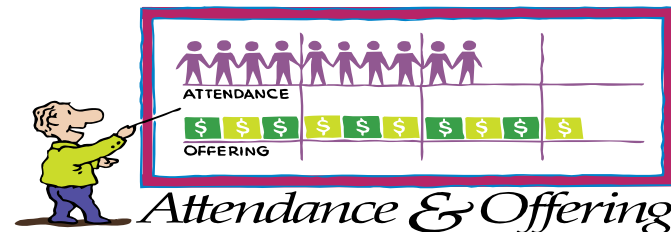

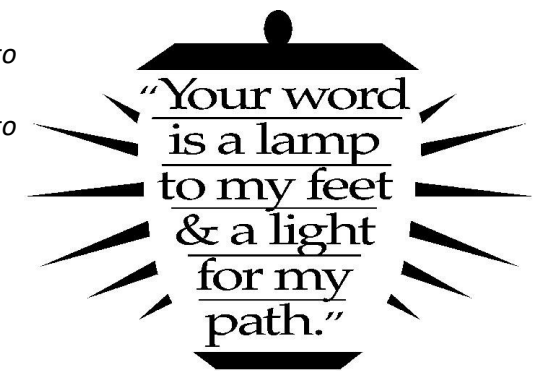

GOD'S WORD – A LAMP AND A LIGHT

As you know, for the past few weeks, we have heard some great lessons from Tim Neal from the book of Psalms, and we have been encouraged to read this great book to gain insight into the love and faithfulness of God and what He desires for us as Christians.

One of my favorite verses in this book is Psalms 119:109, of which we sing periodically at Southside. Here are some of the lyrics to this song, written by Michael W. Smith:

*Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path
Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path
When I feel afraid
Think I lost my way
Still your there right beside me
And nothing will I fear
As long as you are near
Please be near me to the end ...*



Psalm 119:105

With the events that we have experienced during the past few weeks, including the assassination attempt of former President Trump, and the division of our nation overall as we enter unto this election season, we need to heed these words more than ever.

The word translated lamp in this passage is ner in the original Hebrew. It refers to a small clay lantern with a solitary wick. The psalmist describes the word of God as a lamp carried on his journey to distinguish the way and keep him from stumbling off course and going astray. The light of God's Word allows us to see the right direction. It is God's guidance for our travels through life on earth. I Peter 1:19 describes God's Word as a "reliable lamp shining in a dark place."

Paul taught the young man Timothy in I Timothy 3:16-17 that "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip His people to do every good work."

In conclusion, I encourage each one of you to get into the Word, read it, study it, and meditate on it. With an active prayer life and being in the Word, God will "be there right beside you" and "lighting our path" as we march on our way to Heaven with Him eternally.
