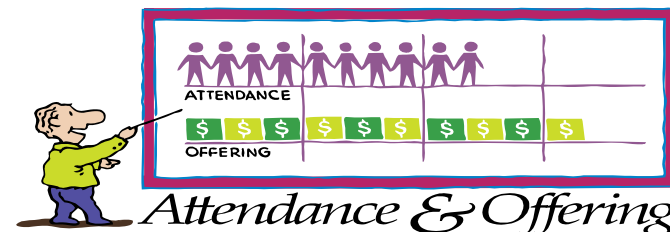

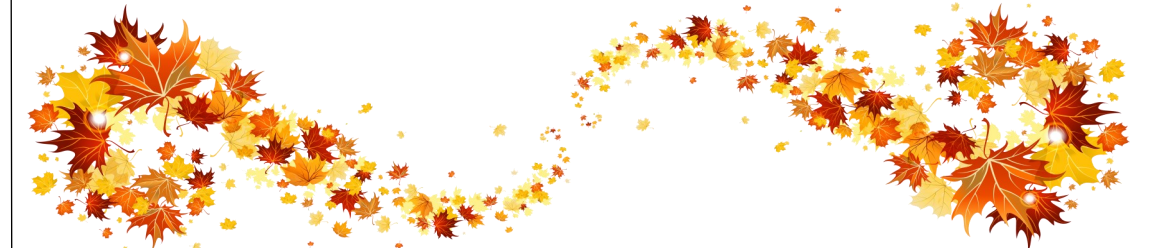

# Sew Sisters

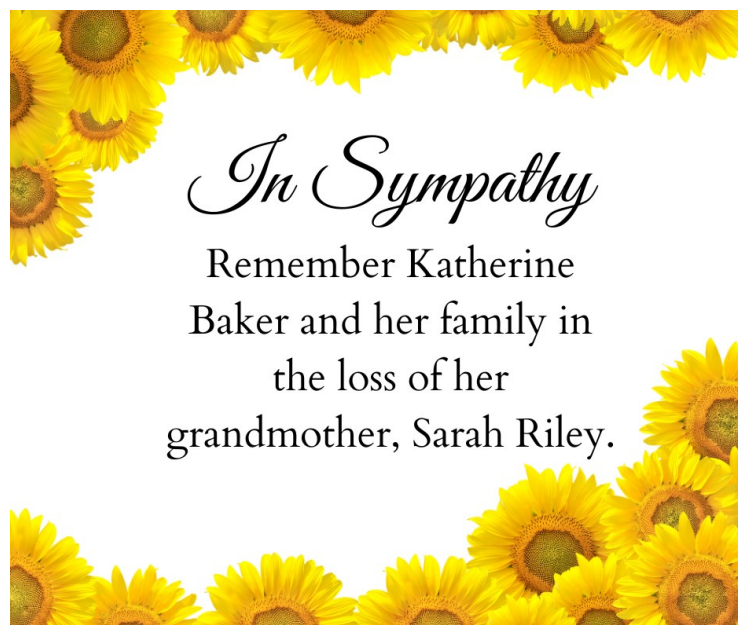
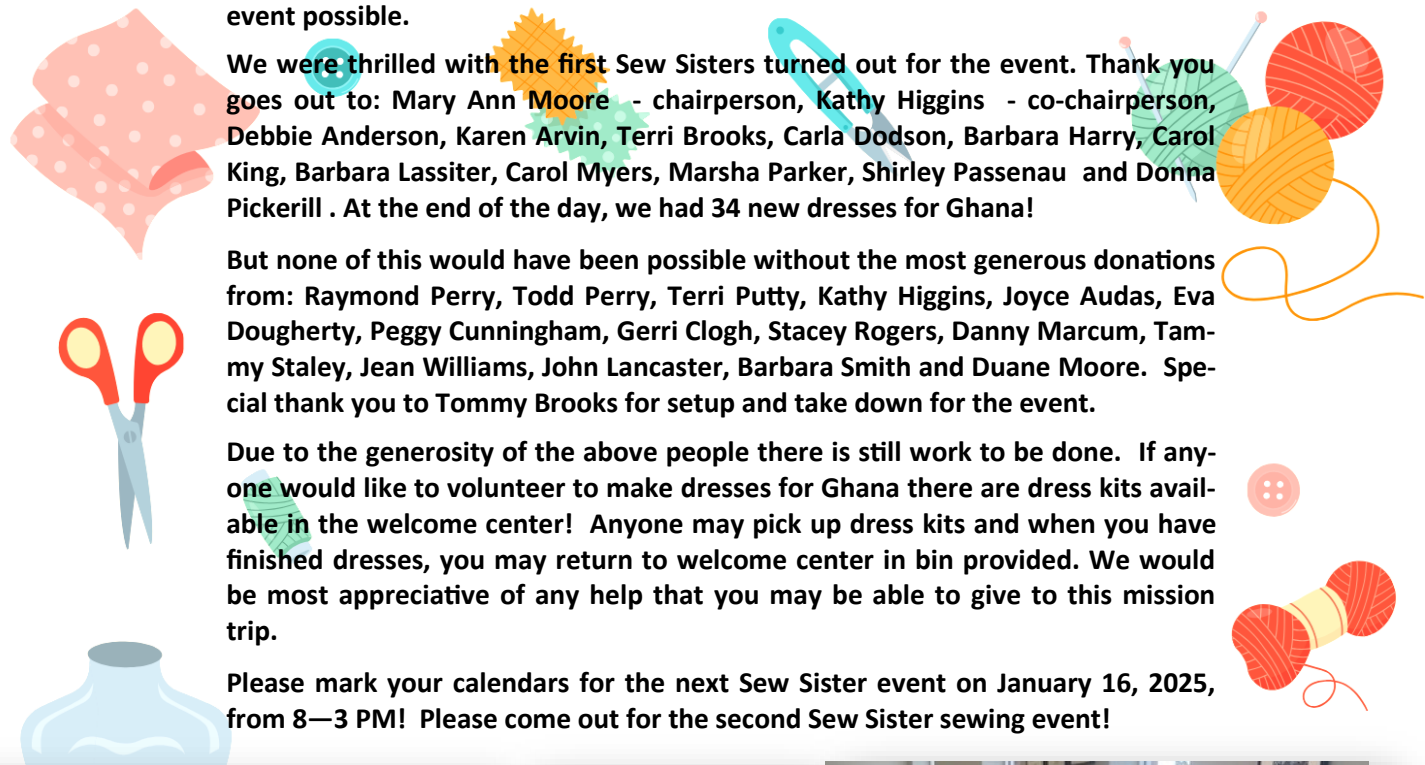
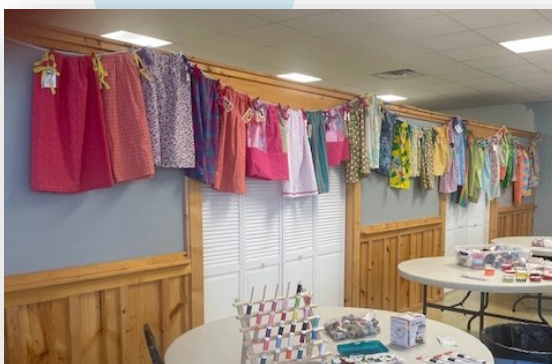
Sew Sisters had a great first sewing event held September 26, 2024 in the education building. We are most grateful for those that made donations to make this event possible.
