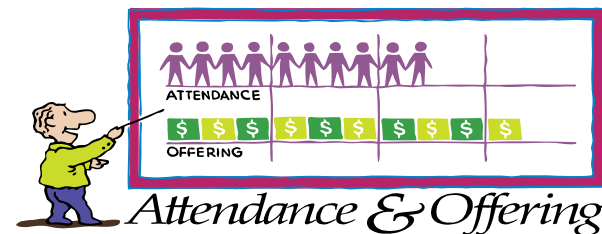

### Gratitude

When I think about the Church, and Southside in particular, the word that rushes to mind is Gratitude. I am so thankful for the seed of faith that was planted in the nursery roll, and encouraged through many years by so many Sunday School teachers, ministers, and mentors. My initial assignment as deacon was to lead the children's ministry. There are so very many people who volunteer to teach, and this assignment was very rewarding. Lindsey's background as a teacher helped, as she stepped into the role of coordinating lessons for the different children's classes. This programming has since changed, we adopted the Kingdom's Kids program, Peyton Crump has fulfilled the deacon leadership role in this area, and Donna Pickerill has worked so hard to coordinate the lessons. Lindsey and I still enjoy working with the children as regulars on the teaching rotation, and also teaching in our Bible Bowl program every Spring quarter.

My current deacon leadership roles are within building and facility maintenance, and also the Senior Ministry. We have recently completed a replacement of all windows in the main building. Men like Tommy Brooks, and several others over the years, have served in a day-to-day role to care for the facilities on the Southside campus. Maintenance and upkeep is a continual challenge, and as needs are recognized, I encourage everyone to notify me, Ricky Wells, or Tommy. The Senior Ministry is able to schedule and execute outings and programs on their own. Some trips they have made include Potter's Home in Bowling Green, New Pathways, World Christian Broadcasting in Nashville, and multiple social outings to break bread together. The purpose of this group is to encourage our senior members to engage with one another and promote involvement in the Church. There is so much that our seniors have to offer, and we want them to know that they are loved and valued. 
