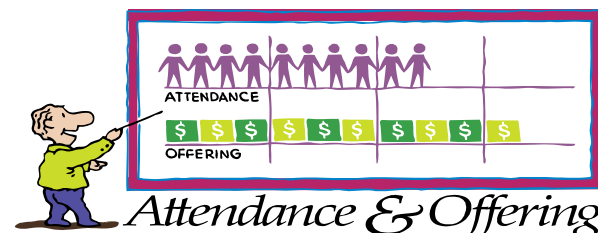

## A Congregation of Generosity

I have served as an Elder here at Southside now for over 10 years. Wow, time really does fly by. In the time since Tammy and I moved back to Hopkinsville in 2000, I have always been impressed by the generosity of this congregation over the years. We may be small in numbers compared to other Churches of Christ, but we give like a larger body. I remember when the idea of building a Family Life Center (gym) was originally put on the table by the elders before me and over \$150,000 was raised to get that project started. Some time ago, we started using fifth Sunday's (Sundays) to raise funds for special projects outside the budget. They have ranged from Capital Campaigns like building our gym, to supporting Youth Activities in the summer, to the most important in my mind, mission work.

Today we will use the first fifth Sunday of the year to support Youth activities this summer ranging from Camp Can Do, to the Taylor Christian Youth Camp, to Vacation Bible School. We will also use part of the money to help with our Summer Youth intern, Caleb Todd, who will be joining us for ten weeks this summer.

What I am even more excited about, however, is our next fifth Sunday opportunity at the end of June. When our missionary, Ricardo Avarado, was with us a few weeks back, he shared with the elders his desire to build a new church building on the site of the one they currently use. It is very old. They recently saved \$2,000 (which took them a year) to enclose their property with a privacy fence. They would like to tear down their old building and build a new one on the current concrete slab, which they estimate will cost about \$20,000. Southside has been amazing it its support of Dorian Flynn over the years, and most recently Kayley Wadlington in her trip to the UK last year. The Elders would like to step up and help Ricardo and his mission efforts in a big way this year. Our hope is to raise the necessary funds to help our church in Liberia, Costa Rica rebuild their building from the ground up. Ricardo's church has great momentum right now and we can help support them in a way I don't think we ever have before.

Please be in prayer for how you choose to give, and for our fifth Sunday on June 29th later this year, that the Lord's generosity will be shown to our brothers and sister in Costa Rica as we raise money to rebuild the church in Liberia. Everything over our weekly budget that day will go towards this effort.
