

As the back-to-school season begins it brings new routines, fresh opportunities and sometimes a mix of excitement mingled with nervousness. I heard this from some of the moms and dads among our church family, in fact several of our students will be beginning at a new school this year with new people and new teachers, others will be starting school for the very first time. For these kids, as well as for parents and teachers alike, this is a reminder to remember that God goes before us in every new chapter. Proverbs 3:5-6 instructs us to "trust in the Lord with all our hearts and lean not on our own understanding." Whether facing an unfamiliar classroom, a challenging subject, or simply the busyness of the school year, we can rest in the assurance that God is guiding our steps and providing strength for each day.

I'd like to encourage you to let this season be more than just a return to bell schedules and school supplies—let it be a time to grow in faith and purpose. Equip your children to approach each day with prayer and a heart open to God's presence. Jesus spoke directly to students and many of His teachings offer powerful guidance that applies to anyone learning or growing, including our own kindergarten kids and college bound freshmen. Jesus was often addressed as Teacher ("Rabbi"), and His disciples were essentially students (Mark 10:51, John 3:2). While His advice was primarily for His followers, these are universal principles which come directly from the heart of God:

Be Humble and Teachable: Jesus praised childlike humility and a willingness to learn: "Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:4).

Love Others: School isn't just about books—it's about relationships too. It's a call to kindness, respect, and compassion in every classroom or campus. Jesus said, "Love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:39).

Don't Worry: This is especially comforting for students facing exams, deadlines, or new experiences: "Do not be anxious about tomorrow..." (Matthew 6:34).

Jesus invited people to learn from Him and emphasized the importance of being open-hearted, humble seekers (Matthew 11:29). May this school year be filled with wisdom, peace and a renewed desire to walk closely with Christ in every classroom, hallway and conversation we encounter (Matthew 7:24). May God bless our local schools, teachers and administrators, parents and students, and all the behind-the-scenes servants who assist them.
