The time and energy spent planning and organizing the lessons and crafts has been a labor of love – join us as we pray for God's blessings over the week as well as for the hearts of the children who will attend and learn more about the life of Jesus. You may have noticed the wooden signage on the north lawn advertising the theme for the week: S'more of Jesus! S'mores are a wonderfully messy childhood treat that capture the essence of campfires, gathering on summer nights and rustic pleasures. It's a cute play on words since we always want some more of Jesus; so, think with me about what it would actually be like to sit around a tent and have s'mores with Jesus. Or even more personal, imagine if it was just you and Jesus.

Have you ever been alone with God? It is a difficult thing to accomplish in this busy season, especially in a fast-paced society, but it is necessary. We need to have personal experiences with the Lord for many reasons; we must be able to get away from all the crowds and the bustling because in solitude with Him is where His greatest works occur. The disciples of Jesus were always hearing Him teach and explain the Kingdom of God to the multitudes, but this public listening wasn't enough. The gospel according to Mark says that "When Jesus was alone...they came to Him and asked" (4:10). If we really want more of Jesus, if our minds are to be taught by Jesus, if our hearts are to be shaped by Jesus, we cannot simply rely on the group interactions that we see Him having with others; we must get alone with Him. We listen to many things He says in the overall classroom of Church and in big corporate events, but they are not really useful to us until God gets alone with us about them. Have you invited Him into the quiet campfire times of your life? I recommend you do...it is where He teaches us the most: "When they were alone, He expounded all things to His disciples" (Mark 4:34).


