

### If You Don't Like the Weather in Kentucky...

How many times have you heard the statement, "If you don't like the weather in Kentucky, wait a few minutes and it will change"? That statement seems to be true for everything we deal with on a day-to-day basis. Everything in this world changes. In fact, the older I get, the faster things seem to change. Sometimes it is extremely difficult to deal with these changes.

One example that came to my attention less than a week ago is how it seems people do not have the patience they once did, especially when they are behind the wheel of a vehicle. I have often heard it said, "The only thing around here that is constant is change." In fact, I have used that statement many times myself. Change can be frustrating, to say the least, but it appears that change has become the new way of life.



Psalm 18:2


Isn't it reassuring that our Father in heaven does not change? There are several instances in the Bible where God is referred to as a Rock. In Deuteronomy 32, Moses refers to God as "the Rock" five times.
