

Giving Thanks

The winter months are approaching quickly! All around the area, Kentucky's leaves are quietly beginning to remind us of the beauty within autumn's seasonal transition and the blessings which will soon be ours as we prepare for the upcoming holidays. Thanksgiving and Christmas are two of the most special times of the year for all Americans, but especially for Christians. During these times, millions of people are made aware of two of the most important aspects of the gospel: gratitude & incarnation.

As for the gratitude, about 400 years ago in present-day Massachusetts, English Pilgrims from the Mayflower and members of the Wampanoag tribal groups celebrated together the generous bounty of God upon their first year of crops with a three day feast. The tradition of collectively giving thanks was established and maintained, even co-opted by George Washington in 1789 to give thanks for the successful establishment of the new U.S. Constitution. The following century, Abraham Lincoln framed the last Thursday in November as a day of gratitude and healing for a divided nation in 1863. In 1941 Congress officially established Thanksgiving as a national holiday and set the date as the fourth Thursday in November, where it remains today as a practical reminder of God's goodness and a symbol of national humility. **What a great time of year to be intentional about counting our blessings and sharing them with others...to reflect away from the strife of the world and into a deeper appreciation for all that God has done for us in Christ Jesus.** Please make every effort to prayerfully engage in the end of the year happenings here at Southside, including service projects, our upcoming tribute to veterans, the precious Celebration of Life video, and the Thanksgiving-week-devotional service. Perhaps this November, by the grace of God and through the power of His Holy Spirit, the verse we find in Hebrews 12:28 might come to mean something deeper than ever before: "...since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe." - tn
