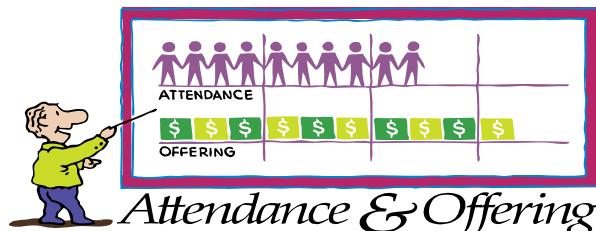

### “FELLA! YOU KNOW YOU’RE GOING TO DIE SOMEDAY, DON’T YOU?”

I'm sure, most of you are familiar with the reality series Duck Dynasty, that was so popular from 2012 -2017. But if you're not, it was a reality show that followed the Robertson family and their successful duck hunting business called Duck Commander in West Monroe, Louisiana. The business was started by the Patriarch of the family, Phil Robertson and his wife Kay. They and their four boys, managed to build a duck call dynasty, with a call that Phil designed and manufactured in a shed out behind their house and began by selling out of the trunk of his car. From those humble beginnings they have morphed into a 500-million-dollar company.

Phil grew up hard. With a father, that worked long hours on oil rigs and gone from home a good part of the time, and a mother that suffered with alcoholism and mental illness, he was one of seven children. He was a star athlete in high school and went to Louisiana tech on a football scholarship. and he kept Terry Bradshaw on the bench until Phil's senior year when he gave up the game so he could hunt more. Go figure that... better than aNFL hall of fame quarterback and walked away. I guess GOD had other plans. Phil managed to finish school and get a master's degree in education. He even taught for a few years but his heart was always on his passion to spend time in the outdoors.

Phil lived a rough life. Hunting, fishing, drinking and carousing. He even bought a bar and had Kay and the boys helping to run it. So much for bringing your children up in the way of the Lord. All that changed though, because his sister loved him enough to bring a minister down to the bar and tell him about the GOOD NEWS. While it didn't make much of an impact the first time, the seed was planted and through some troubled times it finally took root and grew. When he finally understood what he had been missing, and that without Christ he was lost, he gave in to the Gospel and was baptized at the age of 28. He spent the next 51 years telling others about the GOOD NEWS.

He tells the story of a guy calling trying to order a duck call. In the space of that short conversation the fellow cursed, taking GOD's name in vain five times. Phil had finally had enough and asked him why he would talk like that? The guy asks if he has his call and Phil replies he's got it and guy hangs up. Ten minutes go by and the guy calls back. He says “Mr. Robertson, I never thought about that, about my language I mean”. Phil said “Well fella, you know you're going to die one of these days, don't you?” The guy responds “well yeah I know I'm gonna die someday,” Phil's response was “if you know you're going to die, why in the world would you curse the only one I know that could save you?” He said” I tell you what. You only live 8 or 9 hours from here why don't you just come on down and I will tell you a story about the one you are cursing.” The fella says “I might just do that” and hangs up. A week later, a truck pulls up in Phil's yard. Big ol boy from Alabama gets out. Has a friend with him. He asks Phil “you know who I am? Phil says “don't think so.” Guy says ‘I am the guy from Alabama that was cursing God.’ Phil knew then, who he was and he took he and his buddy inside his house and told them about Jesus. Just like, that minister had done for him. Both those men cried, repented and Phil baptized them in river right outside his front door.

In Matthew 28 we read that.” All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey all that I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Phil says, that is putting GOD's word in action and maybe it is as simple as asking “Well Fella! You do know you're gong to die one of these days? Let me tell you a story about the only one, I know that can save you.”

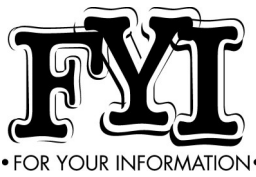
