




The brothers and sisters in the jungles suffer the most because of the rivers and roads; everything is difficult to access. However, the word of the Lord flows through all the communities, just as the rivers flow. We are in the process of finishing a house of worship for the brothers and sisters in Wala. The government is repairing the 300km road south of Panama City, which is in terrible condition. All the other congregations are currently inaccessible. Summer will arrive in January, God willing! We will have about four months of summer, months that we are making the most of. Teaching the new converts is underway. Brothers and sisters, my wife is getting worse every day with Alzheimer's. She is 71 years old; the doctors say it's natural at that age. I have to spend more time with her and take her everywhere I go. Right now, we're three hours from home, helping a congregation with their apartment; we're going to redo it. Brothers and sisters, thank you for your prayers and financial support; without it, it would be very difficult to share the gospel of Christ with these people. May God always bless you. Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year to every member. The Lord is closer today than yesterday; let us remain prepared by maintaining good spiritual health.
