


SOUTHSIDE **CHURCH of CHRIST**



The First Seven

The seven figures in the painting above represent the original men who were chosen to serve in the early Church through the office of a deacon by caring for the poor, sick, elderly, widowed, and otherwise marginalized people of God back in the first century (Acts 6:3). Pictured here are **Stephen**, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit; also **Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas** from Antioch, who was a convert to Judaism. Church deacons have very important Biblical roles focused on service, compassion, and support, and the work of deacons is vital within every Christian community. However, what is even more impactful than their actions is their character: these men must have the Spiritual maturity of being trustworthy, self-controlled, committed to their faith and to their family, and to living lives of integrity (1 Timothy 3:8-13). I am thankful to have such men serving Southside, aren't you?

We are blessed today to be lead in our worship service by the team of deacons here among us, and this is a wonderful opportunity to thank them publicly not only for their faithful support of us and each other, but also for all the work they do behind the scenes to help accomplish tasks, achieve goals and ensure the success of fruitful ministries in this congregation. 
