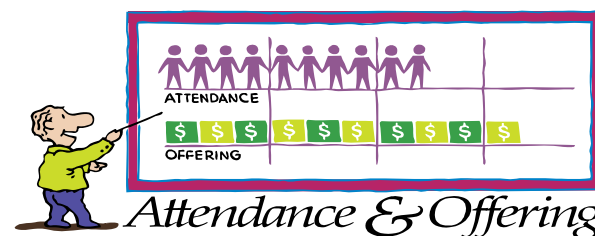

What a great time of the year to celebrate the love in our lives and to honor the only One who truly loves perfectly. Christians are called to operate in God's love by first abiding in His love personally and allowing it to shape our attitudes and actions toward others. Jesus said, "As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Abide in My love" (John 15:9). This abiding relationship with Christ produces love as a supernatural fruit of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22) because when believers remain rooted in humble prayer, Scripture, and devotion to God, we are continually renewed and reminded of the grace we have received. 1 John 4:19 teaches, "We love because He first loved us," showing that Christian love is not self-generated but flows from experiencing God's love firsthand.

Christians also operate in God's love by practicing humility, forgiveness, and selflessness in our relationships. Scripture commands us to be kind to one another, to be "tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you" (Ephesians 4:32). This kind of love is patient and sacrificial, reflecting the description found in 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, where love is portrayed as patient, kind, and not accusatory. By choosing to bear with one another (Colossians 3:13) and placing others' needs above our own (Philippians 2:3-4), believers are able to demonstrate the tangible reality of God's love both within the home and within the larger body of Christ.

Finally, Christians operate in God's love by actively serving and encouraging one another in unity. Jesus declared, "by this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). And again, "Let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth" (1 John 3:18). Through acts of service, generosity, prayer, and mutual encouragement (Hebrews 10:24-25) believers reflect Christ's heart to one another. In doing so, we build up the church, maintain unity in the Spirit (Ephesians 4:3), and bear witness to the transforming power of God's love. - t.n.

 Warm greetings from Panama. Beloved, due to the weather, it has been difficult for us to visit our Kuna brothers and sisters in the jungle. We should have been here since December, but it hasn't stopped raining since then. Several bridges have been washed away by the rivers—five in total. The rivers are rising from two feet to over twenty feet. We maintain personal contact with the congregations near the Pan-American Highway. At night, we communicate with those in the jungle via WhatsApp. We are all persevering in the Lord. Beloved, my wife is ill; she has Alzheimer's. In addition, some doctors believe she has tumors in her breasts and uterus. We are having all the necessary tests done to help her live a healthier life. She will be 72 on the 14th of this month. Because I have to be with her due to her Alzheimer's, I haven't been able to dedicate much time to ministry. Sometimes I manage to sneak away with her to be with the brothers and sisters. 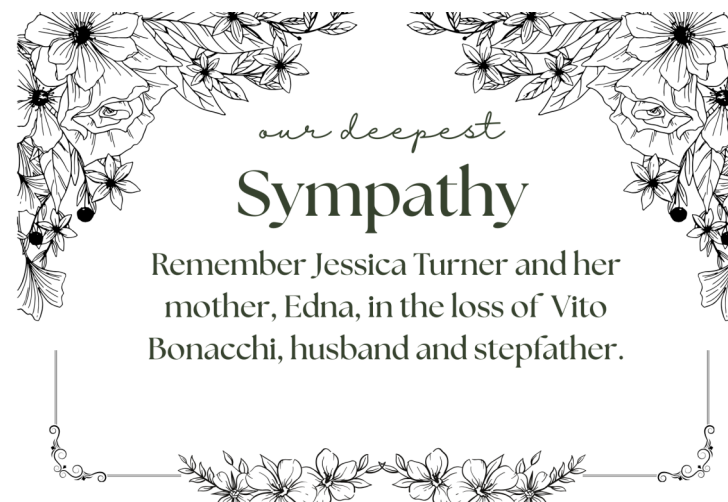
