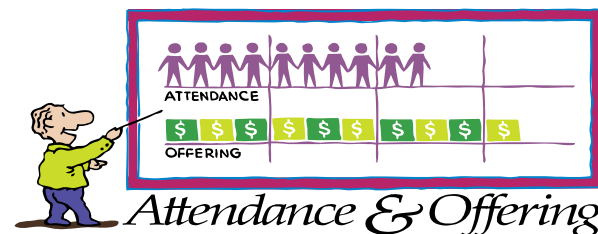

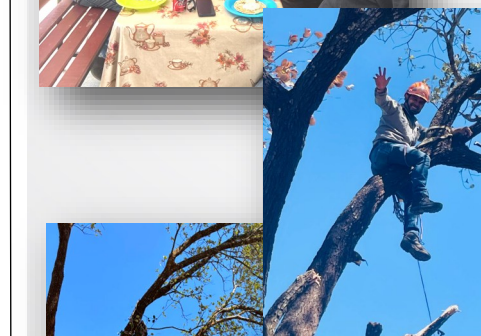
Report from Costa Rica

We will also have a catered fellowship meal following our morning worship service.

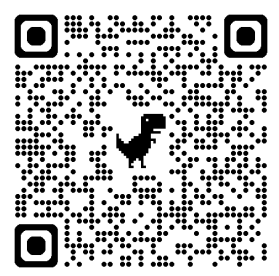
LADS2 LEADERS
