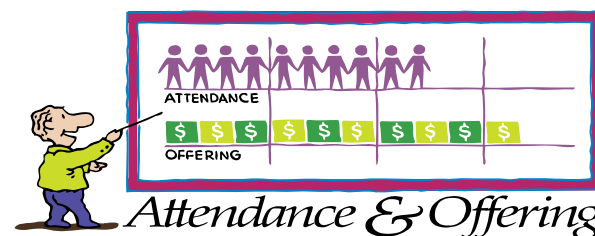

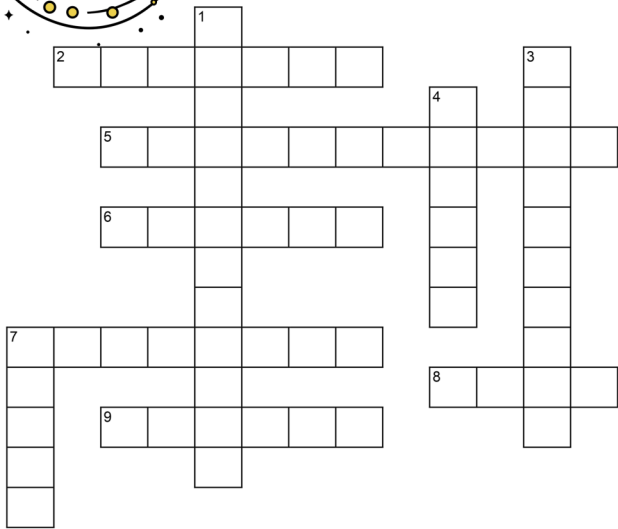

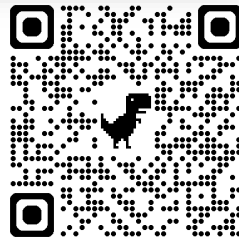

### Camper Sign Up

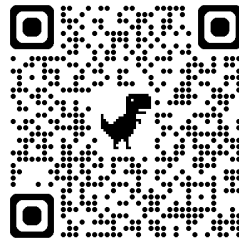
