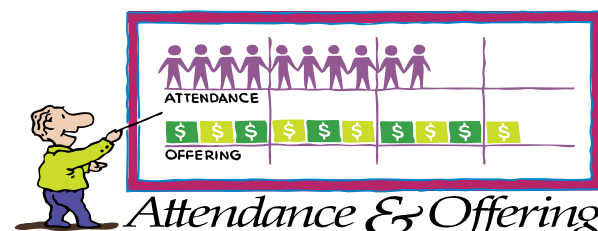

The first speaker will be Jeff Jenkins, followed by Michael Crowder, Desroy Reid, Bart Warren, Tim Parish, John Dale, Jackson Wells and finishing with Les Chapman. The lessons will be taken from the book of Daniel, with discussions on how to stay faithful in a culture that challenges Biblical values.

We are all familiar with the many instances of Daniel being tested but he still stood firm in his faith. Although he wasn't mentioned by name in Hebrews 11, also known as the Hall of Heroes of Faith chapter, it states in verses 33-34 that by faith these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice and received what God had promised them. They shut the mouths of lions and quenched the flames of fire. Heat can come in different forms to Christians who are trying to remain faithful. It could be criticism, temptation, loss, suffering or standing alone for Biblical truth. As Christians, modern culture has pressured us to conform or be silent about our beliefs. Even more concerning is when Christians feel pressured to affirm the sinful actions of this world.

Romans 1:32 states "Although they know God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve death, they not only continue to do these very things but also approve of those who practice them."

I would encourage everyone to support this year's Summer Series and to take this time to build on and strengthen our faith through the examples of faith and courage that Daniel has set before us.

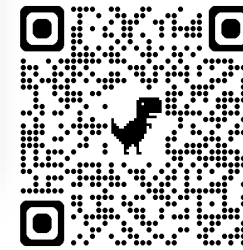

Camper Sign Up

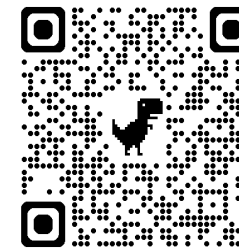
